Parish council John Cousans. Following a lot of pressure from your Parish Council we managed to convince the District Council to designate the village as a 30mph zone and install new speed limit signs.

With the assistance from villagers all of the footpaths in the Parish have been walked an a report submitted to the District Council for repairs and improvements where necessary.

Parish Plan

If you recall, your parish council sent a questionnaire to all households in the parish this summer, and over 90% of you replied. Well done! One it has been analysed we will be using the feedback received from this questionnaire to form the basis of a 10 year 'Parish Plan'. We have now secured sufficient funding from Hambleton District Council and the Yorkshire Rural Community Council to allow this project to go ahead. A small steering group is being formed, guided by Jo Buffey from YRCC. This group aims to produce a Parish Plan by this time next year and everyone in the parish is welcome to provide comments. This plan will be produced and a copy printed

and delivered to every household for future reference.

Obviously it may not be possible for every comment or idea to be fully realised, as we need to assess and act upon a consensus of your views to benefit the majority of parishioners. 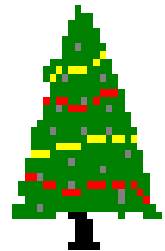
Village Tree
