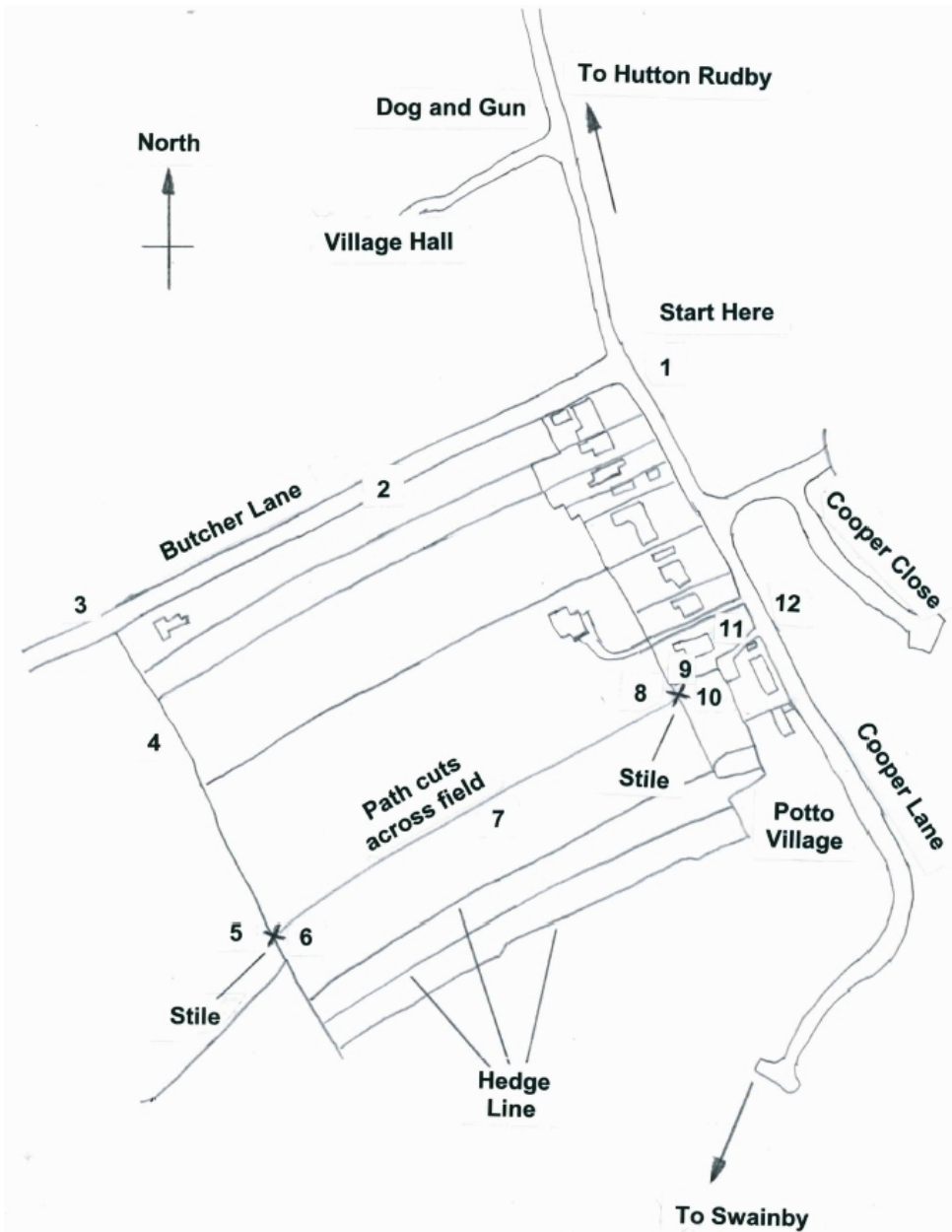


WALKS AROUND THE PARISH OF POTTO

Walk No. 5

- Start** - at the Noticeboard on Cooper Lane.
Finish - at the Noticeboard on Cooper Lane.
Duration - approx 15 minutes.

Some parts of this walk cross a field, which is likely to contain loose horses. There are some nettles or hedges close to the path or stiles. Other parts are on public roads. This walk is suitable for those with small children, as there are only two small stiles to climb over. There is also one wooden gate. There are excellent views of the hills looking towards Swainby.



Remember to follow the Country Code. Close all gates, do not disturb farm animals and take all of your litter home.

1. Start at the Noticeboard on Cooper Lane and walk West down Butcher Lane



2. Continue along Butcher Lane facing the oncoming traffic



7. Cross the field, being aware if there are horses present



8. Climb over the low wooden stile at the East edge of the field



3. Turn left at the footpath sign, just past 'Lane House'



4. Walk along the edge of the cultivated field, following the hedge



9. Go along the grassy track towards a wooden gate in the left corner



10. Go through the gate, close it and keep straight ahead



5. Climb over the first stile on your left, 25 yards before the end of the field



6. Enter the field and walk across the middle towards the opposite stile



11. Follow the track and go past a small stone building



12. Turn left into Cooper Lane, noting the footpath sign and walk back up to the Start
